The Deputy Chief of Operations is a FLSA exempt position that works Monday-Friday, and the career Lieutenants and Firefighter/EMT's work a rotational 48/96 shift.

The Worley Fire District is a combination rural Fire District located in southern Kootenai County, Idaho. The District is 121 square miles in size operating out of 5 Stations with 22 apparatus to provide BLS Level Emergency Medical Transport, Rescue, HazMat Operations, Wildland as well as Structural Fire Suppression. The District encompasses the City of Worley, Farm and Timber ground several Lake Front Communities as well as several miles of Coeur D'Alene Lake. A large percentage of our population is seasonal with a year a round population base of 3,500 growing to over 10,000 during the summer months. Our annual call volume is just under 500, with 80-90 percent of those calls being Medical type incidents.

The Communities in and around Worley Fire District are vibrant and growing with many recreational, cultural and business amenities. Our residents enjoy a high quality of life by being able to live in a small community and still be just minutes away from larger cities like Coeur D'Alene, Idaho or Spokane, Washington.

There are several recreational opportunities in and around Worley Fire District. The southern end of Coeur D'Alene Lake lies within Worley Fire District boundaries as well as 3 Golf Courses and 3 Full Service Marinas.
